Given the current circumstances of the Corona pandemic, you and we must observe certain rules very strictly. Please read the following carefully and also read the links. (Unfortunately, there is no English translation of the links.)

Place of exams:

Lecture Halls Chemie 1 + 2, Gerhard-Domagk-Straße 1, 53121 Bonn (Endenich).

Make yourself familiar where this is and how to reach it !

Time of exams:

(1) for Topologie I: 9:00 - 11:00 Bachelor students HS Chemie 1 (right) Master students HS Chemie 2 (left)

(2) for Topologie II: 12:00 - 14:00 Bachelor students HS Chemie 1 (right) Master students HS Chemie 2 (left)

Please, arrive 30 minutes before the exam and wait outside the building !

You need:

Pencil (and eraser), your Studentenausweis, an identity card with photo (Lichtbildausweis) or passport.

Mask (Mund-Nase-Bedeckung).

You don't need:

Books, notes, scripts. Phones must be switched-off.

Please note: If you write both exams, you need to fill-in and sign this form for each exam.

*With your signature you declare that you have read the **Handreichung für Prüfungen in Präsenz** and agree to the rules set-up there. This includes (a) that you had no contact with corona positive people within the last 14 days, (b) that you are free of any corona symptoms up to the time of the exams, and (c) that you will tell the Department for Public Health (Gesundheitsamt) if you will be tested corona positive within the following 14 days.*

Rules for the exam:

a) We need to keep a distances of at least 1.5 meters inside any university building. This is particularly important while entering or leaving the building. And avoid to stand together in groups outside the building before and after the exam.

b) You must wear a mask (Mund-Nase-Bedeckung) inside the building. You are allowed to take it off when you have reached your place for the exam. You need to put it on when using the toilet or when leaving the building. You need to put it on if someone needs to leave your row of seats and you have to let her/him out.

c) Entrance: We will let you into the building one-by-one, but this takes time.

- Bachelor students go to the right to HS Chemie 1,

- Master students go to the left to HS Chemie 2.

There are two doors to each lecture hall which you use alternatingly. We fill the lecture hall beginning with row 1, then row 2 and so on. There are two places in each row, one to be accessed from the left, one from the right way. (See the hall plans.) You keep all your belongings at your place; thus you please bring only the necessary things.

d) The exam will lie at your place, — don't start yet. Each place has a number like **2.08A** on the working surface, meaning HS Chemie 2, row 08, place A (left when looking from the blackboard), or **1.12.B** meaning HS Chemie 1, row 12, place B (right).

Now you write your **name, your matriculation number and this place number** on the front page of the exam. Put next to you: your Studentenausweis, your identity card or Passport, and the signed 'Formular zur Kontaktverfolgung' which we collect. *During this, please, keep on your mask !*

e) When we give the signal to start working, *we still ask you to keep on the mask for a few minutes* while we check identities.

f) If you have a question, raise your hand. We need time to give the people near you a sign to put on their mask before we can approach you.

g) If you need to use the toilet, people near you need to put on their mask when you leave and re-enter. This takes time.

h) Leaving: When you have finished your exam you must wait till the end. Leave your exam at your place. We empty the lecture hall in the opposite way, namely beginning with the last row. *Don't forget to put on your mask !*

i) If you are writing both exams bring something to eat in the break between the exams; but you can't have this lunch break inside the building.

Klausureinsicht:

The exams will be marked in the following week; the marks can be found in BASIS on Wednesday afternoon, August 5th. As you may have heard you can see your marked exam via the Zentrale Klausureinsicht, beginning Thursday, August 6th; but you need to register. To register, you need to write an email to klausureinsicht@math.uni-bonn.de, state your name, matriculation number, the module number of the exam, and ask for a time slot. Then write any complaints at a post-it and attach it to the exam; I will re-mark those exams after August 24th.
